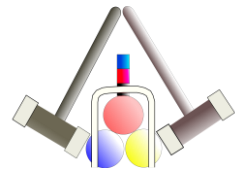

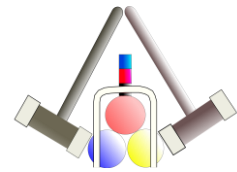

KCC CROQUET ACTIVITIES

In the first round of the Northside Plaque competition, played at Killara against Warrawee our team of Liz Montague, Ron Bradner, Mary Lambert, Jenny Bennett and Geoff Hunter were very successful – winning all singles matches and winning by 56-46 points. In the next round, on April 11, Killara meets Chatswood at Chatswood.

The outcome of the Patricia Porritt Trophy, which was played on 12th March, was on a knife-edge for the two hours it took for Ron Buist and Jim Whitehead to defeat Pat Glandian and Norma Evennett in the final. In the 18 point tussle, Ron and Jim finally won 10-9.

Killara players are involved (or will be very soon) in many tournaments – some of them nearby and others well beyond Sydney, or even NSW –

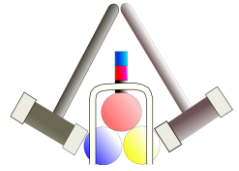
